Course feedback analysis

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28 students registered for the course, 19 participated in the course exam, and 14 passed the course (74% of those participating in the exam). In general, the attendance at the lectures was very good.

The final session was held on 18.10.2011 during which course feedback was also discussed. Several points were mentioned during the discussions and the written feedback that are considered below.

In addition to the feedback discussion, two students submitted the course feedback form. Based on this feedback, the overall grade of the course was 4/5.

In general, the course was found to be useful and very interesting. Discussions during the lectures were mentioned as a good thing. Indeed, discussions and questions during the lectures were encouraged on this course.

The identified improvements pertain to the scheduling and structure of the exercises. The workload for the exercises varied, and that the exercise questions could have been published sooner to give more time to work on the answers.

The workload of the course could be balanced by considering the deadlines of the exercise submissions. In addition, the exercise questions can be made public at the start of the course. These will be taken into account when planning the 2012 course.
